It is with deep sadness that the 2020 Summer Camp programs at Camp Onomia today have been cancelled. The Camp Board, in consultation with state and local health officials, has determined that the window that we were hoping for to allow us to hold several weeks of our resident camp programs just isn't going to happen this year. At this time, state regulations do not allow for any resident camp programs to operate, and they do not know when that may change with the current trends in the pandemic. So in the interest of keeping campers and staff safe from the infection, we are closing up Camp Onomia indefinitely to conserve funds and to make sure that we can be here for you next year.

REFUNDS

Please know that lack of income from our summer programs and fall retreats will catastrophically affect our financial situation. If you are able to donate all or a portion of your deposited funds to help Camp Onomia out through this financial dry period, we will be extremely grateful.

Should you choose a full or partial refund, you WILL receive your money back by check or by credit card refund (method of original deposits.) A second option is to allow us to simply FORWARD your present deposits to a future retreat program or 2021 summer camp session. In effect, this provides us a small short term loan to help us through the months ahead. We are thankful for anything you can do to make sure Camp Onomia will be here for you when this pandemic passes.
